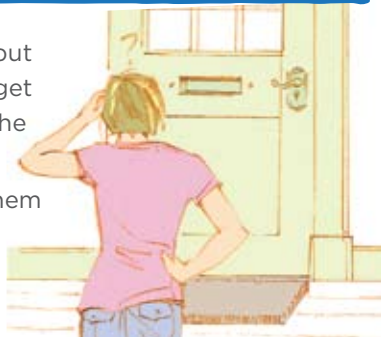

REGISTER WITH MYSQA TO GET YOUR RESULTS BY TEXT OR EMAIL...

Your results will arrive on 5 August, but if you register with MySQA you can get them by text or e-mail first thing in the morning? **No waiting for the Postie!**

And if you're on holiday we'll send them direct to your mobile, wherever in the world you are.



- 1** Find your Scottish Candidate Number (SCN) and a unique e-mail address.
- 2** Go online to www.mysqa.org.uk,
- 3** Confirm your home address.
- 4** We will send your activation code by letter to that address.
- 5** Use this to access your account.
- 6** Choose to receive your results by text, e-mail or both.

Simple. Texts and emails will be sent by 9am on the morning of the 5 August. And you'll still receive your paper certificate.

Registration is now open - **YOU MUST REGISTER BY 5pm ON TUESDAY 8 JULY, AND ACTIVATE YOUR ACCOUNT BY 5pm ON WEDNESDAY 16 JULY.**

ANY QUESTIONS?

"I registered for MySQA last year - do I need to register again?"

You don't have to register again, but do check the address details we hold for you.

"I asked for my results by text last year, will it be the same this year?"

Unless you change your preference, we'll keep them the same way.

"I'm going to be abroad, can I still get them through MySQA?"

You'll still get your text or email - but remember the time difference.

"What happens if I forget my username or password?"

Email us at mysqa@mysqa.org.uk with your details, including your SCN.

"I can't remember my Scottish Candidate Number - what do I do?"

Speak to your school - they will tell you what it is.

"I've heard there's no appeals this year."
